Dear Citizens,

Our Service Centre provides integrated medical, social and psychological counselling and assistance covering the following issues:

- Family planning
- Pregnancy
- Contraception
- Conflicts during pregnancy
- Partnership
- Sexuality

A multidisciplinary team is at your service. You will find:

- Gynaecologist
- Social workers
- Psychologists
- Doctor's assistants
- Administrative clerks

All employees are bound by an obligation of medical confidentiality.

All consultations and examinations are free of charge and do not require a health insurance certificate (Krankenschein).

Family Planning

- Reimbursement of costs for contraceptives for persons on low income (supporting documents must be provided)
- Advice regarding questions about contraception and regarding contraception methods
- Insertion of IUDs and implants, prescription of the "morning-after" pill for eligible women etc.
- Gynaecological examinations and prescription of contraceptives for women without health insurance

Pregnancy

- Counselling and assistance for expectant mothers and fathers as regards medical, legal, economic and social issues (e.g. applications to the Family Assistance Foundation (Stiftung Hilfe für die Familie))
- Medical care and examination of women without health insurance based on maternity guidelines, in particular where medical risks are involved
- Medical and psychosocial counselling for prenatal diagnostics and aftercare
- Information about prenatal classes

Counselling in Conflicts during Pregnancy

- Determining pregnancy, medical examinations and counselling, where required
- Counselling in conflict situations
- Counselling under Section 218 et seq. of the German Criminal Code and issue of certificate regarding legally required counselling
- Information about financial issues, e.g. about public assistance
- Counselling on abortion methods and the costs system
- After-care

Counselling for Individuals and Couples

- Partnership conflicts and marriage crises
- Conflicts during separation
- Crises and conflicts during pregnancy and after a child is born

Sex education

- Consultation session for individuals and small groups
